- be a consultee eg planning applications, health services, transport, and a number of other National, County and District issues and policies
- assist with fulfilling the Council's statutory responsibilities

You will need lots of energy and enthusiasm, and have a genuine interest in the future of Bar Hill, with a desire and the commitment to make improvements for the benefit of our whole community.

You must be a British and/or commonwealth subject or European national or Ireland and attained the age of 18 years and

- a) on that day is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the area of the Authority; and/or
- b) has during the whole 12 months preceding that day occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in the area; and/or
- c) his or her principal or only place of work during that 12 months has been in the area; or
- d) during the whole 12 months has resided in that area; and/or
- e) during the whole 12 months has resided in the Parish or within 4.8km (3miles) of it free of either a criminal record or bankruptcy (see also Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972 regarding disqualification)
